Defining Symptoms	Insulin cannot hold blood sugar stable – too much or too little. Constant thirst, frequent urination, dizziness, shakes & sweats, fainting, seizures, coma	Runny nose, sore throat, cough, sneezing, itchy/watery eyes; perhaps mild fever, body aches	Compulsive drug use in spite of bad things happening; tolerance for drug goes up or down, loss of control, symptoms of withdrawal, obsession with use. Organ(s) effected	Pancreas & blood stream (all others eventually)	Respiratory system; doesn't usually spread to other organs	Brain (all others eventually)
Course of Disease	Chronic – must be treated as a change in "way of life". If not managed, steady deterioration in quality of life, daily functioning, damage to multiple organ systems and amputation of limbs. Risk of relapse is characteristic; can be fatal if not treated. 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
